

**CHARGES FOR NONHUMAN PRIMATE QUARANTINE**  
**Fiscal year 2008-2009**

A charge of \$260.00 is applied for each nonhuman primate undergoing quarantine. This charge covers the cost of:

3 TB tests  
examination  
ivermectin treatment for endoparasites  
fecal evaluation for parasites  
enteric culture  
complete blood count  
blood chemistry analysis  
serum banking  
tattoo

In addition to the above charge, some primates require additional testing. The charges for these tests are:

Two Herpes B tests for those macaques that are requested to be Herpes B negative	\$43.68 X 2 = \$87.36
Filovirus tests for rhesus and cynomolgus monkeys	\$60.32
Retrovirus panel for all macaques	\$80.71
Tech time to check TB tests	\$46.00/hr

Any treatments or medications that are administered during quarantine are charged individually, based on cost of medication and technician time required for treatment.
