


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Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs) in the US




STIs cost the US healthcare system.

While STDs are increasing across many groups, 2019 STD RATES WERE:








FROM 2017 TO 2021, OVERALL REPORTED STDS INCREASED 7%




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






Lower abdominal or pelvic pain in females

Bleeding between periods in females

Spotting after intercourse in females

Gonorrhea Signs and symptoms



In female

Greenish yellow or whitish Discharge from private parts (in females) & penis (in males)

Conjunctivitis (redness, itchiness in eyes)

Swollen glands in the throat (due to oral sex)

Syphilis

Secondary Syphilis **Primary Syphilis** Appearance of a single or multiple, · Weeks or months after the chancre chancre(s) at the spot where the heals, skin rashes and/or sores in the bacteria entered the body. mucous membranes (mouth, vagina or anus) may start to form. 2 Latent Syphilis **Tertiary Syphilis** Known as the late, hidden or sleeping Affects multiple organ systems, stage, the latent stage is where causing a number of health complications depending on which symptoms no longer occur. organ systems are affected 3





Different symptoms can manifest in laterstage disease. Screening guidelines are not so simple. Care for chronic infections is challenging.

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
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Older adults <u>are</u> sexually active.

- Patient-provider relationship
- Cultural views
- Stigma and embarrassment

Taking ageism out of the STI equation:

Normalize discussion of sex

Inclusion of OAs in trials

Expand and maintain education
