

Strong West Urine Microscopic:

New Orderable Test

Date: December 10th, 2024

Effective Date: December 18th, 2024

Urine microscopic testing will be performed on-site at the Strong West laboratory for the Strong West Emergency Department only starting December 18th, 2024. Urinalysis testing will be standardized between Strong West and Strong Memorial Hospital, eliminating need for the SWUA (Strong West Urinalysis) test in favor of the UAR (Urinalysis with Reflex to Microscopic) test. SWUA will become obsolete. For urinalysis dipstick testing with reflex to urine microscopic testing, please order **UAR**.

Collection, storage and testing of samples will follow the same criteria as SWUA testing. Please refer to UAR in the University of Rochester Test Index for details.
